LIKE A DEATH SENTENCE

Seven years ago, she went with her story - the contact with their children from the first marriage is denied her - to the public. We asked how she's doing today.

It was a single signature that would put the lives of the then 23-year-old Claudia from Wels completely upside down. In a friendly manner she gave her ex-husband the custody of their child. The good intention that they go about their job and the children would be well supplied with the Father. From friendship basis was a struggle. A struggle for children to love and especially to a mother's right. Claudia Redlhammer processed their tragic story appeared in the 2006 novel "The dirty woman." Extensive media coverage ensued, great consternation. How is the "bad mother" today? She continues to fight for contact with their grown-up children. And she wants one thing: to help people in similar situations!

Woman: Mrs. Redlhammer how are you today, after they have reflected your story so intense?

Redlhammer: I have cherished for a long time self-loathing. When I made the signature 17 years ago, it was like a death sentence. Like a person who dies, and will not come back I also do not get my children back. But it I am still searching for the meaning of it,...the whole time.

Woman: When did you see your big kids, Milan and Alexandra, the last time?

Redlhammer: After several years abroad, I now live since three years in Wels. The town is small and I see the two again once a while on the road. But I can not touch them, they say, I am not her mother. They are in contact with their half-siblings in a while. Especially Milan sees Sophie Marie sometimes, not regularly. And in the family I'm trying to still keep room for the two of them.

Woman: When was the last personal contact?

Redlhammer: I keep trying to contact the two by email. The answers are usually not very friendly. Since I am sometimes offended I feel almost childlike, because I think they are great but want to know what is really going on. I have the certainty that they go to some point on the search for the truth. I would not call it hope, but I know that it will happen.

Woman: After this tragic story of child alienation, because it was not difficult for you to start a new family with her second husband?

Redlhammer: Not at all. For me it was much more of a gift that I can be the mother of children. I love my kids, even the adults. At the beginning we even celebrated their birthdays, even though they

were not there.

Woman: What are your hopes for the future of your children and for yourself?

Redhammer: I want them to know that they do not have to hate their mother. Because Wels is a small town and everyone knows everybody here, I also know that they have the two classic symptoms of alienated children. They are aggressive do have difficulties with relationships. I want to help them. I would want justice, that they understand that even though I had done the signature at the time, I am a victim too.

Woman: You have made your destiny history a profession. How can we understand this?

Redhammer: I myself have taken a lot of psychological counseling in claim until I came across the NLP resonance method. With the help of that, blockages in the brain can be resolved. Since this has helped me so quickly, I have to be trained as a certified NLP Coach resonance. Through my own story and the training I can help pairs and alienated children as well. *S Wauthy*
